



Dear Colleague:

The next several months promise to be challenging for the Child Welfare League of America (CWLA) and other organizations fighting to maximize our country's support for children and families. Fifteen million children in the United States currently are living in poverty, with 23% of children under age 5 living below the poverty line—more per capita than in any other industrialized nation. If proposed budget cuts are achieved, we will see thousands more children pushed into poverty or even deeper into poverty.

More than ever before in our close-to-100-year history, CWLA needs to mobilize as many advocates for children as possible under the CWLA umbrella. We need to ensure that when we meet with elected officials on Capitol Hill, we can say that we represent children in each lawmaker's home district. CWLA members have been a valuable force in support of our federal policy efforts: their visits and relationships with their congressional leaders, participation on panel discussions, and active support of the CWLA Advocacy Agenda have made a profound difference. Over the years, CWLA has been at the forefront of the fight for passage of every major child welfare bill and has been a partner with other national organizations on child and family legislation related to substance use, domestic violence, mental health, home health care, prevention of child maltreatment, housing and homelessness, and other issues that help children who are vulnerable and their families.

We cannot stand by quietly and watch our children robbed of their opportunity to flourish as much of the progress made over the years is dismantled.
