Why is SSBG important to Connecticut?

Case Management

During FY 2016, Connecticut assisted 341,663 individuals through case management. Of the 341,663 individuals, 109,018 recipients were children.

Substance Abuse Services

3,544 recipients in Connecticut benefited from substance abuse services in 2017.

Case management services are services or activities for the arrangement, coordination, and monitoring of services to meet the needs of individuals and families.

Home-based services are those in-home services or activities provided to individuals or families to assist with household or personal care activities that improve or maintain adequate family well-being.

Housing services are those services or activities designed to assist individuals or families in locating, obtaining, or retaining suitable housing.

Substance abuse services are those services or activities that are primarily designed to deter, reduce, or eliminate substance abuse or chemical dependence.
