## Why is SSBG important to Iowa?

#### **Case Management**

In 2017, Iowa had 51,956 total referrals for child abuse and neglect. Of those, 30,853 reports were referred for investigation.

SSBG2016 funding will provide case management services to 15,632 children.

#### **Home-Based Services**

SSBG 2016 funded home-based services for 12,815 children. Home based services are those in-home services or activities provided to individuals or families to assist with household or personal care activities that improve or maintain adequate family well-being.

#### **Foster Care Services for Children**

5,952 children in Iowa lived apart from their families in out-of-home care in 2017, compared with 5,565 children in 2016.

#### **Special Services for Disabled Individuals**

During FY2016, funding for special services for disabled individuals in Iowa will aide 1,359 children and 25,245 adults.

#### **Protective Services for Adults**

Iowa provided service to 2,506 adults through SSBG 2016 funding.
