Why is SSBG important to Utah?

Child Abuse and Neglect

In 2017, Utah had 39,222 total referrals for child abuse and neglect. Of those referrals, 20,736 (52.9%) were referred for investigation. There were 9,947 victims of child abuse or neglect in Utah.

Foster Care Services for Children

In 2017, 2,954 children in Utah lived apart from their families in out of home care, compared with 2,838 children in 2010. In addition, SSBG2016 funding will provide case management services to over 11,000 children.

Protective Services for Children

35,754 children received protective services for children funded for by SSBG.

Home-Based Services

SSBG funded home-based services for over 5,100 children and approximately 6,000 adults.

Other Services includes children's ombudsman (case reviews/investigations), services review (case reviews), licensing (foster care licensing), and CAPS (the Department's provider payment system).
