## During her Vice Presidency

- Endorsed investments in Head Start and Pre-K programs

## Education



## During his Administration

- Signed an executive order during the beginning of the Covid-19 pandemic in 2020 with a focus on K-12 education, which provided funds using the Community Services Block Grant program to financially support children with access to in-person education during that period of the pandemic

## Campaign Promises

- Believes in school choice and increasing both financial and extracurricular benefits or resources for children that are homeschooled

## Campaign Promises

- Propose a federal ban on price gouging to lower grocery prices
- Expand Child Tax Credit to \$3,600 per qualifying child, and \$6,000 for children in the first year of life

## During his Administration

- Doubled the child tax credit to \$2,000 per child
- Signed the Family First Prevention Services Act into law, which expanded Title IV-E child welfare entitlement funding for prevention services

## Campaign Promises

- Stated he will lower federal interest rates to decrease inflation and mortgage rates

## During her Vice Presidency

- Working to make Child Care & Development Block Grant funds more accessible to bring down childcare costs on families and cap child-care copayments at 7% of families' income

## Campaign Promises

- Restore reproductive freedoms
- Cap the cost of insulin at \$35 and out-of-pocket expenses for prescription drugs for everyone
- Work with states to cancel medical debt for up to 3 million Americans

## Healthcare & Childcare



## During his Administration

- Signed the Executive Order (EO) on Strengthening the Child Welfare System for America's Children, covering state agency partnerships, essential resources, and federal oversight
- Signed an EO for Combating Human Trafficking and Online Child Exploitation in the United States
- On several occasions waived the foster care nondiscrimination requirements

## Campaign Promises

- Oppose gender affirming care & diverse gender identity
- Make childcare more affordable
- Reduce the overall Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) by almost 30% over a ten-year period
- Proposes to investigate increases in chronic illness across youth populations

## Campaign Promises

- Provide subsidies for local governments to increase affordable housing, and introduce tax incentives for building affordable starter homes
- Mortgage assistance of \$25,000 to first time home buyers
- Call for the construction of 3 million new housing units, aimed at ending the housing supply shortage

- Proposed budget cuts for the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)

- Proposed deportations to lower housing costs

## During her Vice Presidency

- Raised \$4.2 billion in the private sector to stimulate the economy in Central America, in efforts to disincentivize migration to the U.S.

- Implemented a zero-tolerance immigration policy that separated thousands of children from their parents in U.S. Customs and Border Protection facilities
